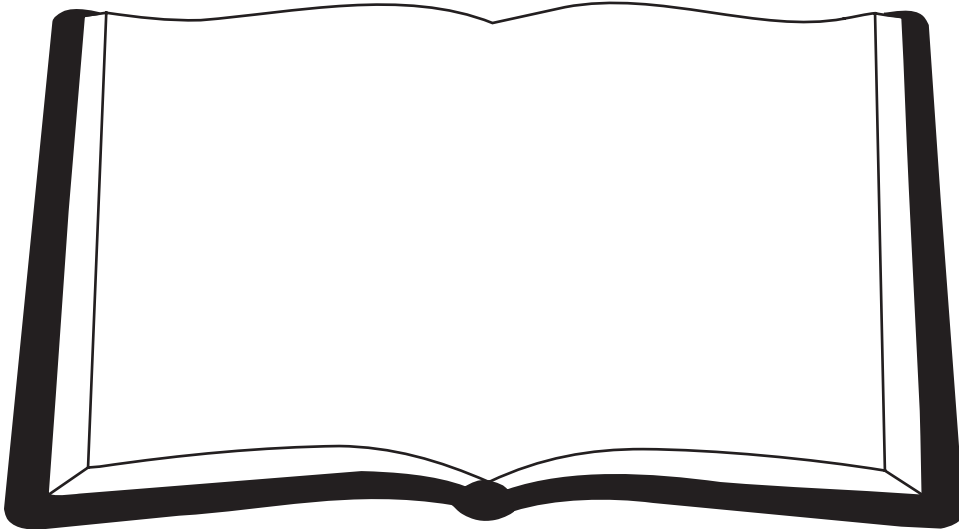
WORD UP! God is in control!

"And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose."

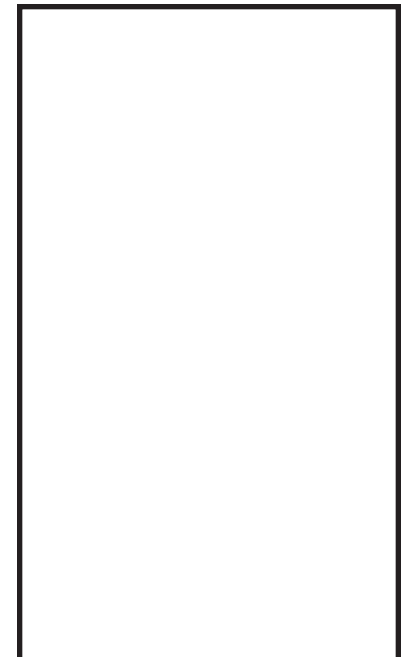

The Bible clearly teaches that God is sovereign—He is in control. Write or draw a picture of something you learned this week in your Quiet Time.

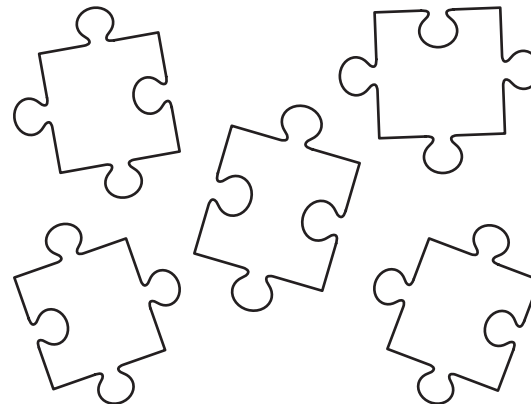

"Whatever the Lord pleases, he does, in heaven and on earth, in the seas and all deeps;"

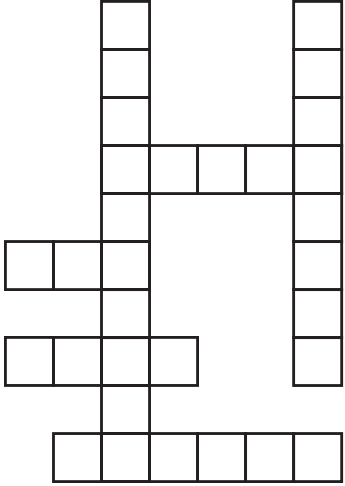
—Psalm 135:6

"...the Lord sits enthroned as king forever;"

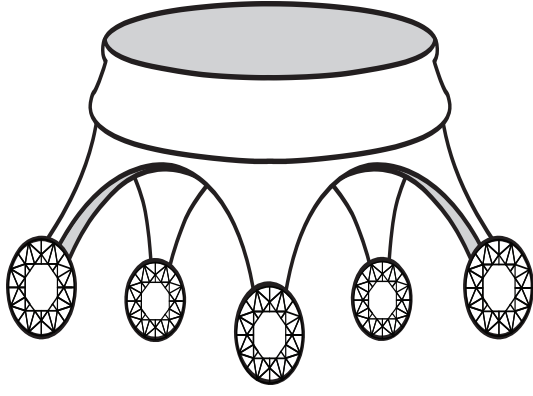
—Psalm 29:10
