When you finish your Quiet Time each day, write something you are thankful for in one of the hearts, then tell God about it and thank Him.

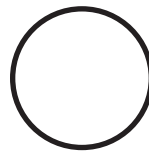
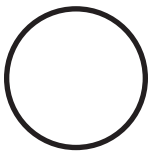


Can you say all four verses four times to four different people? Make a smiley face in each circle when you’ve finished saying it!

—Psalm 147:4

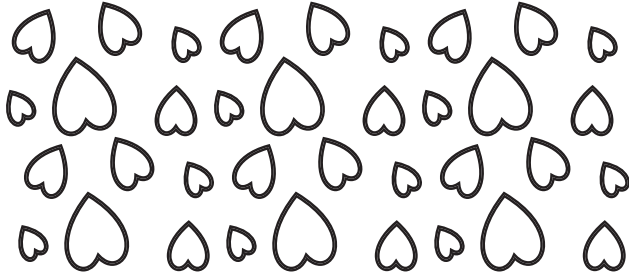
3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

There are many reasons to thank God! This verse tells us two reasons—God is good and loving! There is never a time He is not good. God is also loving. His love lasts forever! The Bible is full of verses of something that shows God's love? It could be something you learned about God from the Bible or something you have seen in your own life.

—Romans 6:23

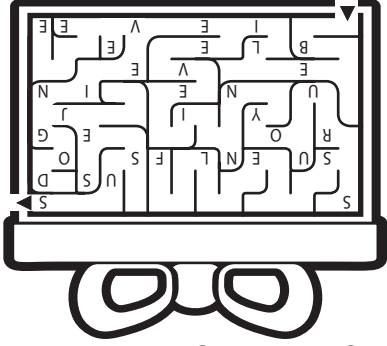
3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Thank God for His amazing gift of new life with Him. Remember that this gift is only through Jesus, who died and came back to life for you.

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

The payment (debt you owe) for your sin is death—to be separated from God and all His goodness. But God didn't want that. He sent Jesus to pay for your sin so you can have eternal life—you can know God and enjoy Him forever. When you believe in Jesus, you no longer have to pay for your sins—that debt is forgiven. This is the greatest thing to be thankful for!

God gives you forgiveness of sin and new life with Him through Jesus as a free gift. You don't have to do anything to earn it. Solve the maze and write the letters to find out how you can have this greatest gift.



2 THINK ABOUT IT!

Paul, the man God used to write this verse, thanked God for the people he was writing to. He also prayed that God would help those people grow to know Jesus better.
