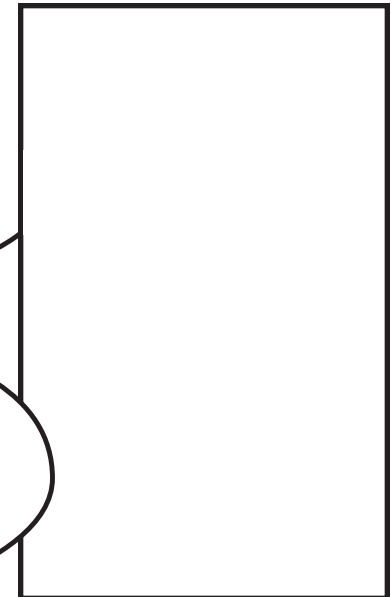
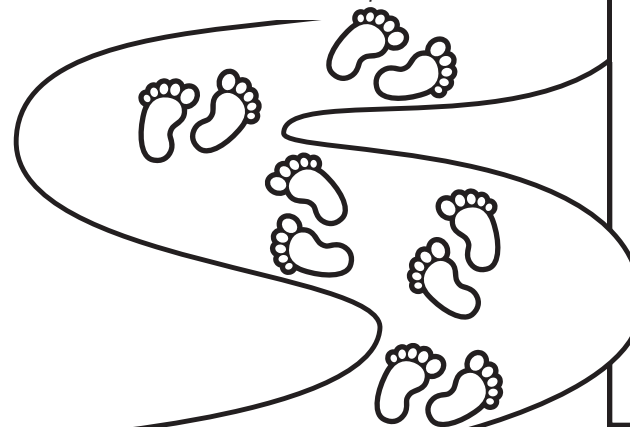

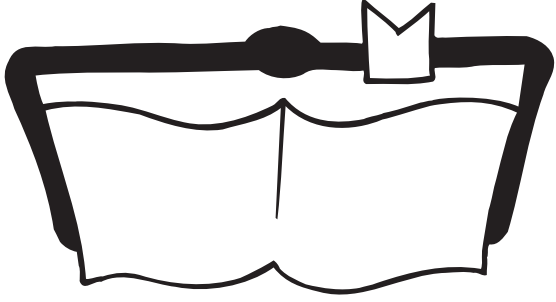

Each day this week, when you complete your Quiet Time, color in a footprint below.

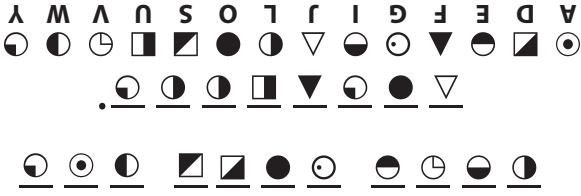




Color in God's Word, the Bible.
