

1 READ ABOUT IT!

"...My [God's] grace is sufficient [more than enough] for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness..."
—2 Corinthians 12:9

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Thank God for His grace. Ask Him to use you, even when you feel weak, to show how awesome He is.

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

God's grace is His great kindness. He gives it to you freely even though you don't deserve it. Remember God is your Helper and He has unlimited power to use you for His good work! WORD UP! God is strong!

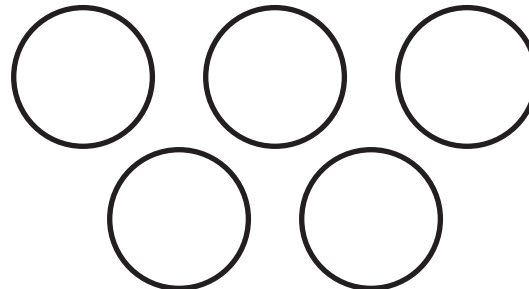
Do you remember your verse? Keep working on it and try to say it to three people this week without looking.

—John 16:33

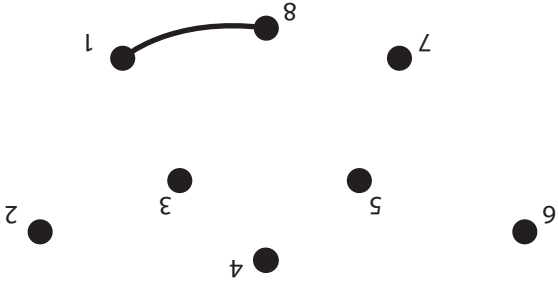
3 PRAY ABOUT IT!
