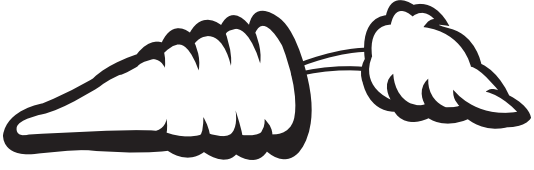

Cross out the B's to find a way you can ask God for wisdom.

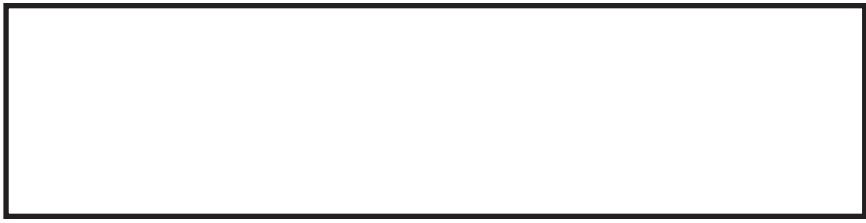

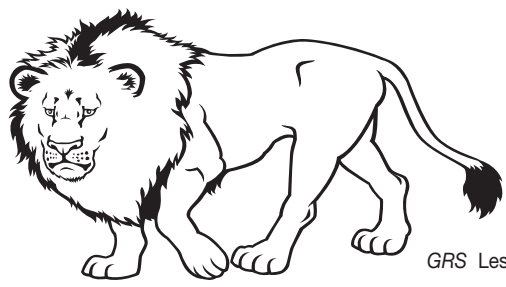

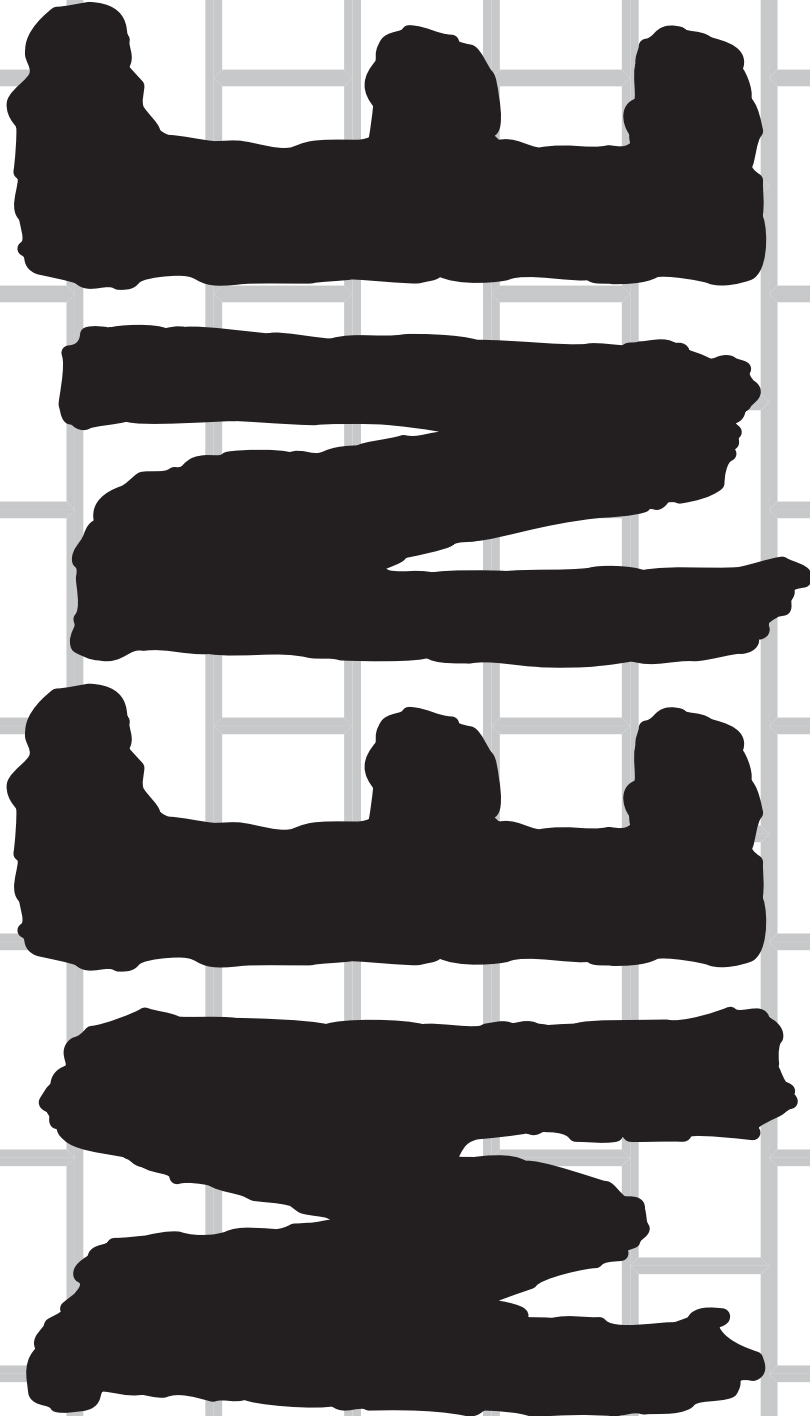

If we confess: Hold out hands, palms up as if showing your sin to God

our sins: thumbs down with both hands

he is faithful and just: thumbs up with both hands,
one hand when you say "faithful" and the other on "just"

to forgive us our sins: point at yourself with both hands

and to cleanse us: rub hands together as if washing them

from all unrighteousness: thumbs down with both hands
