—Jeremiah 10:12

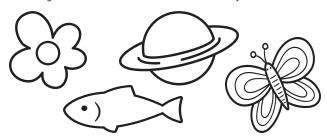
3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

"Casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you."

—1 Peter 5:7

THE PRAY ABOUT IT!

If there's something making you anxious, talk to God about it! Thank God for caring about you and the things that make you anxious.

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

Casting means to "throw." God is telling you to "throw" the things that worry or upset you to God. You can't physically throw the things that make you anxious at God, but you can tell Him about them and how they make you feel. Then you can trust Him with them. The God who created the whole world is even more powerful than whatever is making you anxious. He promises to give strength and help to those who believe in Jesus!

Day 2 • READ ABOUT IT!

"Look at the birds of the air: they neither sow [plant] nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they?"

-Matthew 6:26

⑤ PRAY ABOUT IT!

Think about how much God cares for you and thank Him for it! If you have a need, talk to God about what it is. Remember God often uses others to help. Ask God for courage to talk to an adult you trust about things that make you anxious.

11. THINK ABOUT IT!

When God made the world, it was perfect. But sin, the wrong things you and I do against God, ruined His perfect world. Sin causes many bad things to happen, like sickness, anxious and sad feelings, fighting, and death. Even though the world isn't perfect anymore, God is still powerful! He promises to take care of those who believe in Jesus. God even takes care of the birds. They don't have to worry about their needs because God values them, and God values you way more! If you believe in Jesus, you can trust that God will take care of you! It may not happen the way you think or expect, but you can trust that God will provide.

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Thank God that He is always with those who believe in Jesus! Ask Him to give you wisdom to know the right thing to do and strength to do it. If there is something you need His refuge and strength for, talk to Him about that too.

11. THINK ABOUT IT!

God promises to help those who believe in Jesus during times of trouble. God is your refuge, which means you can trust Him with anything. When you get anxious, you can know God is in control! He is always with you and available to help. God won't always take the thing you are anxious about away, but He will work through it. God can give you the wisdom and strength you need to do what's right in whatever situation you face.
