Every day as you have your Quiet Time with God, remember to study this week's Memory Verse. Knowing God's Word by heart will help you as you live for Him.

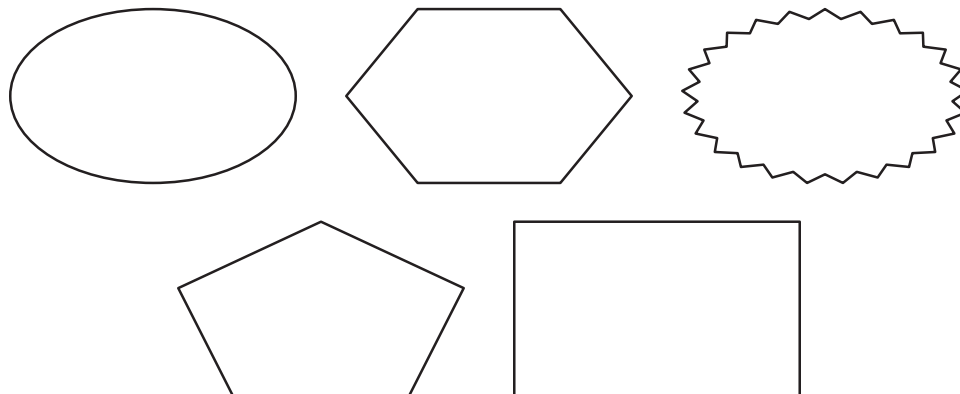
"And we have seen and testify that the Father has sent his Son to be the Savior of the world."

After you have your Quiet Time each day, go tell someone about the verse you read. Then write that person's name in a shape below.



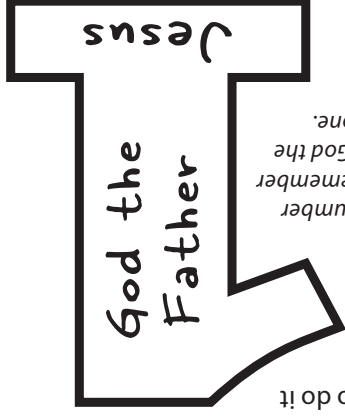
2 THINK ABOUT IT!

In this verse Jesus is telling people He is God. Do you believe Jesus is God? Some people say Jesus never claimed to be God—He was just a good person.

If someone says that to you, you can show them John 10:30.

But remember to do it with gentleness and respect.

Decorate the number one to help you remember that Jesus and God the Father are one.



2 THINK ABOUT IT!

This verse talks about what would happen to Jesus. And it was written hundreds of years before Jesus was born! It's a prophecy—something written in the past about what will happen in the future. When Jesus died on the cross for others, He fulfilled this prophecy and many others. He was wounded when He was beaten and nailed to the cross, where He died. He did this for your sin, just like God said hundreds of years before.

Day 3

"I and the Father are one." —John 10:30

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

God gives lots of reasons that show us He is real and Jesus is God. Thank Him for those things. If you have Jesus as your Savior, ask Him to help you share these reasons with others.

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

Some people you know may not believe Jesus can save people from sin. If you believe in Jesus as your Savior, you need to be ready to tell people why you believe what you believe. But always remember to be kind and respectful. You can show people Jesus' love with what you think, say, and do!

2 THINK ABOUT IT!
