

1 READ ABOUT IT!

"If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."

—1 John 1:9

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

People are not perfect like God is. We choose to go against God's perfect way and sin. Today's verse tells you what to do when you sin. You should confess your sins to God. To confess means you are sorry for your sin and agree with God that what you have done is wrong. When you confess your sin, God promises to forgive you and help you walk closely with Him.

You can walk with God because of what Jesus did for you. Think about what Jesus did for you as you color this picture.



3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Tell God about your sin. Thank God for His forgiveness and ask Him for help to say no to sin.

You have a brand new memory verse this week. Your challenge is to read it out loud three times every day during your Quiet Time. Soon you'll be able to say it without looking!

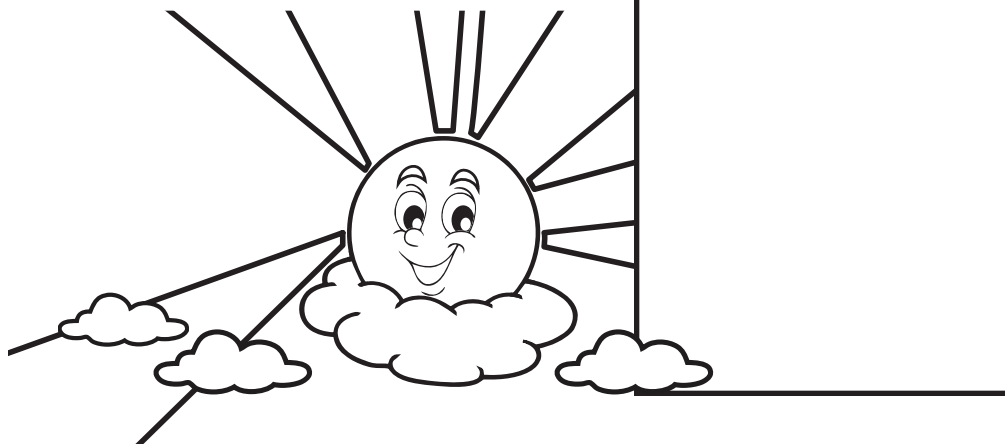
"For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring us to God."

1 READ ABOUT IT!

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Is there a sin you keep remembering that you know God has forgiven? Tell Him about it. Thank Him for forgiving you and ask Him to help you remember that you are forgiven.

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

If you are condemned it means you are guilty and get all the punishment you deserve. But when you believe in Jesus as your Savior, you are not condemned! Jesus took all your sin and now when God looks at you He sees Jesus' goodness. You are forgiven!
