After you have your Quiet Time each day, color in the shape below.

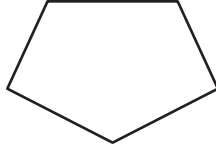
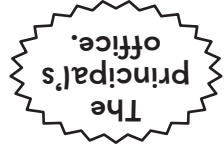
1 READ ABOUT IT!

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!
