3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Ask God to help you live His way and to show others who He is by your actions and words.

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

God's Word, the Bible, uses the words light and darkness to help people think about what God is doing in the world. Darkness is a reminder of the bad things we do and how those bad things lead to sadness. Light is a reminder of Jesus. Like darkness is the opposite of light, Jesus is completely free of sin. Jesus is God. He has the power to remove the darkness of sin from you and me. Instead of sadness, He gives life. And when you believe in Jesus, you have Jesus' light in you. Like you notice a light shining in the dark, other people will notice the difference God has made in your life when you live God's way. 1 READ ABOUT IT!

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Thank God for being perfect and good. Ask Him to help you learn His good way and follow it in your life.



2 THINK ABOUT IT!

This verse shares something everyone should know—that God is perfect! Wait, you might think, where does it say that? When this part of the Bible talks about light, it's talking about doing the good and right thing. When it talks about darkness it's talking about things that are bad and evil. There is no darkness in God—no sin, evil, hatred, or anything bad at all. God is completely good and holy all the time!

1 READ ABOUT IT!

—Ephesians 5:8

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Thank God for saving you and making you His child. Ask Him to help you walk in the light by obeying Him.

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

When you believe in Jesus, you go from being in the darkness of sin to being in the light of the Lord—being forgiven of all your sin! You become God's child and you begin to want to live His way. When you obey what God says to do in the Bible, you are walking as "children of light." The more you read the Bible and learn about what it says, the more you will grow to know God and learn what it looks like to live His way.
