—Ephesians 4:15

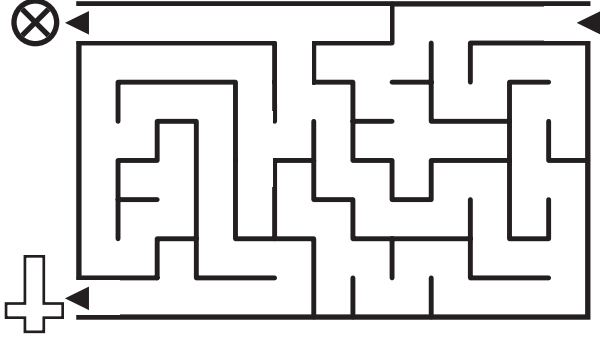
3 PRAY ABOUT IT!
