# Quiet Time

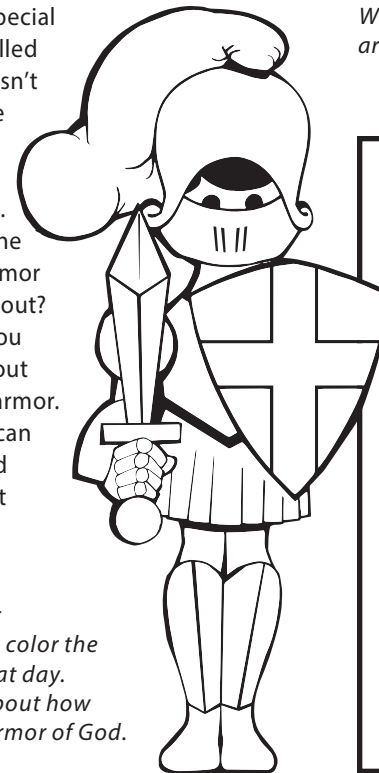
**WORD UP! God gives victory!**

Thank God for giving you the truth in the Bible. Ask Him to help the truth change how you live.

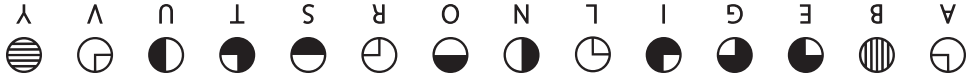
2 THINK ABOUT IT!

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Before you believe in Jesus as your Savior, you are God's enemy because of your sin. You were against Him. But when you believe in Jesus, you are no longer God's enemy. You have peace with Him. In fact, the Bible says you are His child and He loves you with a special love that never ends and can't be taken away. This is what it means to have peace with God!
